

- Administrative Studies with concentration in Innovation & Technology
- Applied Business Analytics

- Financial Management with an *optional* concentration in one of the following:

 - Investment Analysis
- Global Marketing Management

- Supply Chain Management with a *required* concentration in one of the following:
 - Global Business
 - Logistics Management
 - Quantitative Approaches
- **Possibilities for accelerated track for Piura students graduating or graduated from the following degrees:**
 - Bachelor of Business Administration
 - Bachelor of Industrial and Systems Engineering
 - Bachelor of Service Management
- **Curricular Practical Training (CPT)**
 - 4 credit internship option for students pursuing on-campus Administrative Sciences master's degree

 - Graduates of STEM degrees may be eligible for an additional 24 months of off-campus employment via OPT
 - Eligibility: Student completed appropriate program on campus and is in good academic standing at BU

 - TOEFL 84
 - IELTS 6.5
 - Duolingo 110
- GPA Minimum: 3.0
- Proof of Degree Completion
- Home Institution Eligibility Requirements



ADMISSIONS PROCESS

1

International Office at home institution provides MET International with a list of nominated students.

2

Nominated students apply and upload application materials via BU's WebAdMIT application portal.

3

MET International & BU academic department review application materials and MET International distributes admission decisions.

4

Admitted students receive I-20 from MET International, which allows student to apply for an F1 visa at U.S. consulate or embassy.

5

Admitted students must attend mandatory orientation activities.
